



## 2020-2021 Student Uniform Policy

Dear Parents and Guardians of Wakefield Middle School,

Wakefield students will be required to wear uniforms to unify our campus, and provide easy, practical fashion solutions for our families. Wakefield also maintains additional dress expectations to ensure safety, unity, and a commitment to the Wakefield Middle School principles of excellence: to live with integrity, to lead with compassion, and to learn with enthusiasm. Please see below for the Student Uniform Policy and Dress Code:

**Top Garment:** Students should wear a Polo Style 2-3 button shirt, collared with sleeves. The color of the shirt should be: solid black, navy blue or white.

**Bottom Garment:** Students should wear khaki, tan, navy blue or black colored pants, jeans, skirts, or shorts (not athletic shorts). Short length must be at or below the knee. Students are asked to not wear spandex or knit bottom garments.

**Shoes:** Students should wear any color shoes, and any appropriate style. This includes sneakers, casual, sandals. However, shoes should have no more than a 1-inch heel. Sandals must cover 75% of foot.

**Outerwear:** Students should wear jackets and coats of any color. Designs must be appropriate and in alignment with the Tucson Unified School District dress code policy. Jackets and coats should be worn outside. Students are not permitted to wear hoods or hats while on the Wakefield Middle School campus.

**Additions:** In addition to campus expectations for uniforms and student dress, Wakefield Middle School will follow all Tucson Unified School District guidelines for student apparel and dress. For additional questions, please reach out to the Wakefield Middle School front office.
